

**\$1000 SCHOLARSHIP APPLICATION**  
**Dallas Alumnae Panhellenic Association – 2012**

The purpose of this annual scholarship is to promote the Greek system on Texas university campuses.

To qualify, applicants must be a graduating high school senior woman (public or private high school) who resides in the Dallas ISD or Highland Park ISD attendance zones (includes Addison, Highland Park and University Park). If your home address is within the city of Dallas but you are zoned to another school district, you will not qualify. Please note that zip codes will be verified. Applicants must attend an accredited four-year Texas university with National Panhellenic Conference (NPC) sororities on campus in the academic year following high school graduation. **A list of the eligible Texas universities with NPC sororities on campus as well as a list of the 26 NPC sororities and links to their websites** can be found at [www.dallaspanhellenic.org](http://www.dallaspanhellenic.org) under the Scholarships link.

The number of scholarships offered varies from year to year depending on available funds. Scholarship(s) of at least \$1000 will be awarded based upon academic achievement, extra-curricular activities, and financial need.

The recipient must participate in and complete the NPC sorority recruitment process. This does not mean that she is required to pledge a sorority, but she must participate in the process before scholarship funds will be distributed to her university. Scholarship funds will be sent directly to the university upon verification of completion of the recruitment process.
